1. Government of Nepal has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Nepal-India Regional Trade and Transport Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Construction of Kathmandu ICD/CFS (Part-A: Main Block) (Ref No. NIRTTP/PCO/NITDB/W/ICB-4)
2. Ministry of Industry, Commerce & Supplies, Nepal Intermodal Transport Development Board now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the works consisting access road widening, buildings, warehouse, pavement works including necessary river training, drainages, water supply, sewerage, electricity supply etc. The construction period is 18 months.
3. Bidding will be conducted following the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines") and is open to all bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

To qualify for award of contract, eligible Bidders must meet the following key qualifications and other qualifications specified in the bidding documents:

**Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover over the last five (5) years:** US \$ 25,000,000 (in words USD Twenty five million only) *or equivalent and Minimum Two similar civil works contract each with a value of at least USD 12,720,000 (in words USD Twelve million, seventy two hundred thousand only) or equivalent*

4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Employer's address given below and inspect the bidding documents during office hours *till 25<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at the address given below.* The bidding documents are also available for inspection and downloading at <http://www.nitdb.gov.np/> or at <https://www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp>
5. A Pre-bid Conference is scheduled at 12:00 hours on 4 April 2018 at the Employer's office. Bidders are advised to visit the proposed construction site and assess the actual site conditions before submitting their bid.
6. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon submission of a written application to the address below upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of NRs 20,000.00 (in words Nepalese rupees Twenty thousand only) or its equivalent in convertible currency. The method of payment will be: deposit into the Employer's Current Account Number: 1202002/001.007.524 with Nepal Rastra Bank, Thapathali. If so requested, the Bidding Documents can also be sent by post/courier services upon payment of additional cost of NRs. 25,000.00 (in words Nepalese rupees Twenty-five thousand only). However, the Employer will not be responsible for delay or non-delivery of the documents so sent.

Bidders who choose to submit their bid electronically may purchase the hard copy of the bidding documents as mentioned above or may download the bidding documents for e-submission from PPMO's Web Site [www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp](http://www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp). Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost (as specified above) of bidding document in the Office's Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below and the scanned copy (pdf format) of the Bank deposit voucher shall be uploaded by the bidder at the time of electronic submission of the bids. Bids must be valid for 120 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a Bid Security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, in the form of Bank Guarantee equal to NRs 47,000,000 (in words Nepalese rupees Forty-Seven million only) or equivalent convertible currency valid for 148 days from the Bid submission deadline.
8. Sealed bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 12:00 hours on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2018. Electronic bidding is permitted only through E-procurement section of Public Procurement Monitoring Office's website <<https://www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp>> up to the same deadline. Late bids will be rejected.
9. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 13.00 on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at the office of Nepal Intermodal Transport Development Board.
10. If the bid submission deadline or the opening date falls on a government holiday, the deadline shall be extended to the next working day. In such case, the Bid validity period and bid security validity period will be calculated from previously defined bid opening date.
11. The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject, wholly or partly any or all the bids without assigning reason, whatsoever.
